

ESSENTIAL JOB ELEMENTS - PLUMBER

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Lay out, fabricate, assemble, install piping and piping systems, and fixtures.
- 2. Select type of pipe and related materials according to job specifications.
- 3. Plans sequence of installation and activities of apprentices, helpers, and laborers.
- 4. Cuts and threads pipe.
- 5. Cuts openings in walls, floors, and ceilings to install pipe, pipe fittings, and fixtures.
- 6. Joins piping.
- 7. Secures pipe to structures.
- 8. Tests pipe and piping systems for leaks.
- 9. Follows safe work practices.
- 10. Maintains clean and orderly work area.
- 11. Works within precise standards of accuracy.

EXPERIENCE:

- 1. Four (4) years job experience, completion of apprenticeship program or other industry-recognized experience.
- 2. Possess a current Certificate of Competency as Journeyman Plumber. (Applicable to specific job.)
- 3. Operate cutting/bending/threading machines and cutting torch.
- 4. Braze and weld. (Applicable to specific job.)
- 5. Read blueprints, drawings, and job specifications.

PHYSICAL QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Commercial Drivers License (not applicable to all positions).
- 2. Climb up or down ladders, stairs, scaffolds.
- 3. Maintain balance on scaffolding and platforms.
- 4. Reach for, handle and manipulate objects and material.
- 5. Lift and carry objects up to 100 pounds.
- 6. Stoop, kneel, crouch, and crawl.
- 7. Stand and walk for long periods.
- 8. See and hear (either naturally or with correction).
- 9. Work in pits, ditches, and elevated areas.
