Athens-Limestone Surgery Center



M&D has recently started work on the new Athens Surgery Center for Athens-Limestone Hospital, an affiliate of the Huntsville Hospital System. The building is 3 stories, 80,000 square feet, and includes mechanical infrastructure for fitting out spaces for various uses. The first floor will house the Surgery Center, with lay-out for 8 operating rooms, an MRI, CT, Pharmacy, and pre and post operation areas. The second and third floors will likely see use as therapy spaces, doctor's offices, exam rooms, and a gym. The site is located just east of Lindsay Lane on Highway 72 in Athens. Completion is scheduled for summer of 2018.

Beginning in the spring on 2017, M&D Mechanical began working with EVONIK and Jedson Engineering on the construction of a new two-story biomedical device laboratory adjacent to Evonik's existing facility in Birmingham, Alabama. M&D Mechanical was selected to provide the complete mechanical piping system, controlled HVAC air distribution and full plumbing services for this new state of the art facility. This new structure for EVONIK will add the capacity to produce bioresorbable polymers for use in medical devices and controlled-release formulations for parenteral drug delivery. The new facility is expected to be completed early in 2018.



Medical Gas Training Class



In an effort to improve our workforce and provide better service to our clients, M&D held a Medical Gas Training Class July 11th through July 14th. This 32-hour course consists of an extensive and very demanding curriculum, which concluded with a 100 question written exam and hands-on braze test, where students must braze both horizontal and vertical up flow joints. Eleven M&D employees attended this

training to receive and maintain certification as a medical gas installer. We strongly believe in training our workers to be up-to-date and safe in all their projects. Since we have had a flood of medical building projects over the past several months we have experienced a strong need for skilled workers to be proficient in medical gas installing and will continue to provide training for these types of trades.
